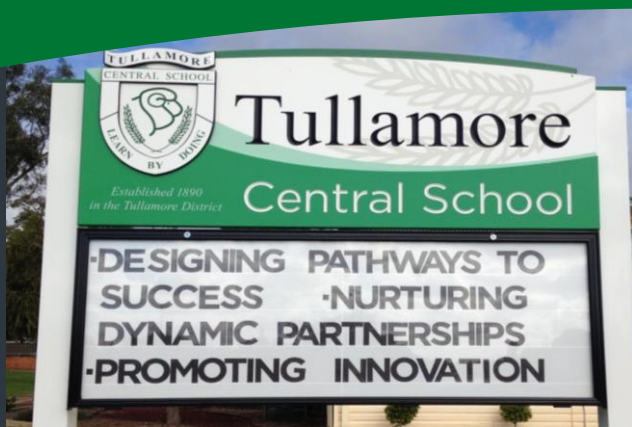

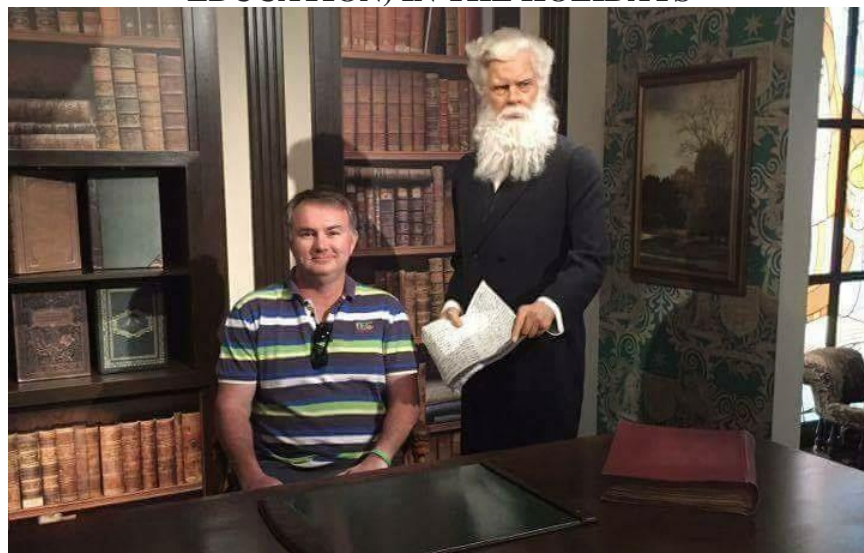

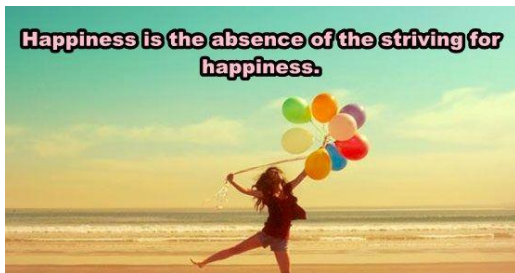

Cattle Show Team

Cattle Show Team will be recommencing after our winter show season. We will be preparing our Bull (Eddie), Cow (Kandy is officially a cow now!) and Heifer (Klover) for Bathurst Royal Show which will be early in 2017 and the early Central West shows that are on during March - May.

Grooming and halter training sessions will commence in Week 3 on the following days:

So that students all have an animal to work with, students will be divided into two groups – a Thursday group and a Friday Group. This will enable us to work on our parading skills as well as our grooming of our cattle. 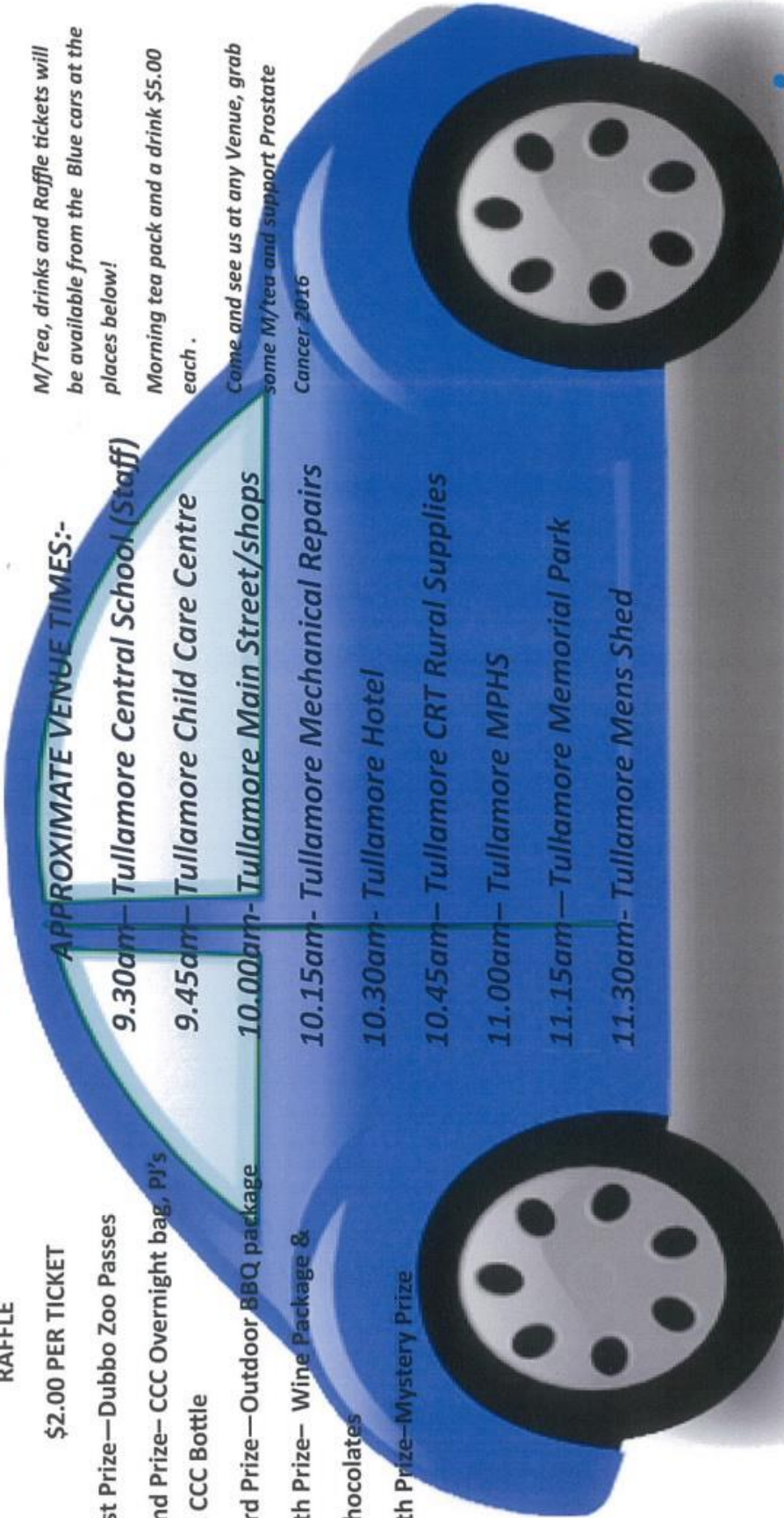

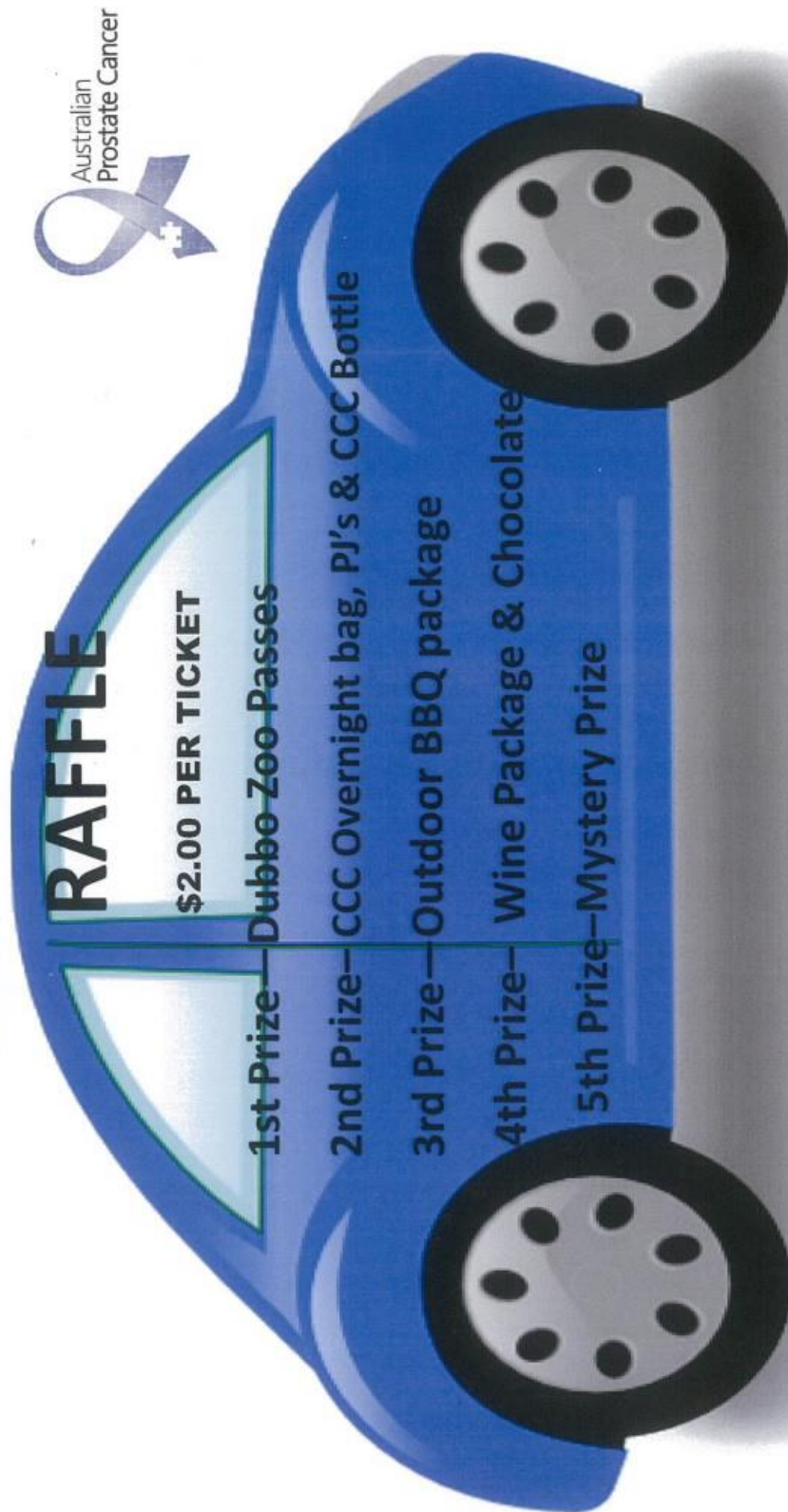
