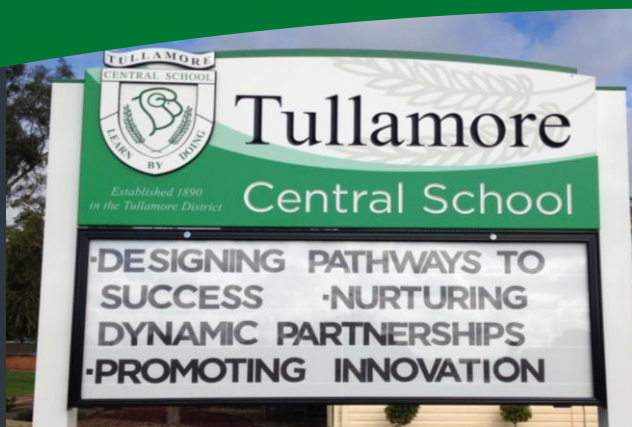

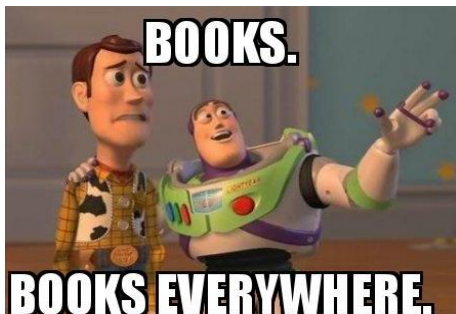
improving our facilities. The student work displays were also impressive, well done to everyone who contributed.

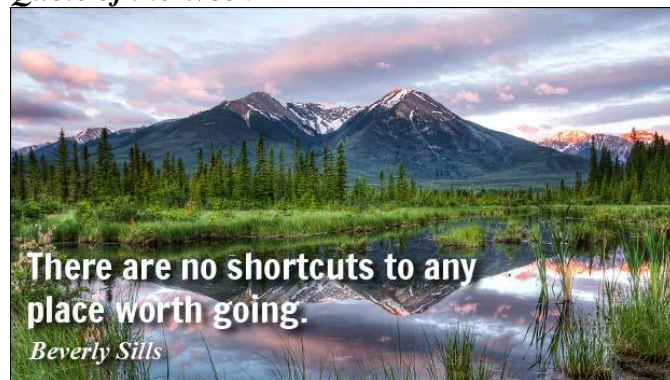
**City to Surf**

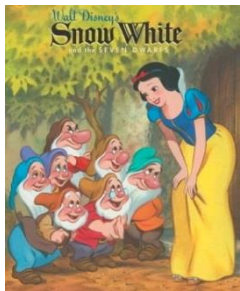

Congratulations to all students on their show entries and prizes. It was great to see Tullamore Central School students entering in so many pavilion events and supporting our local show

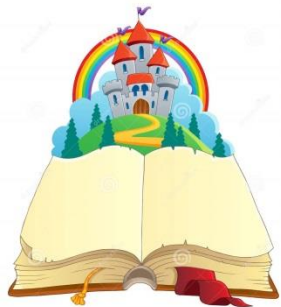
