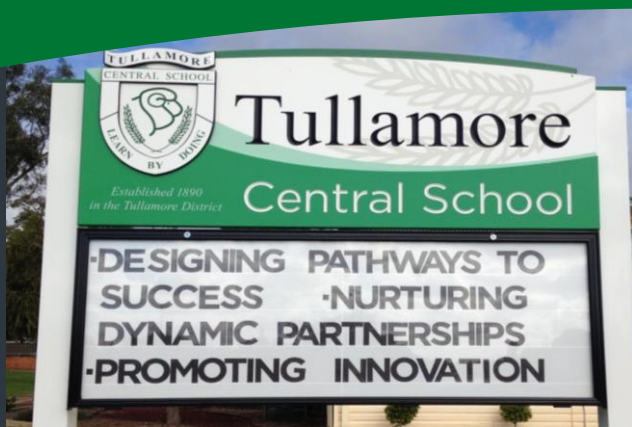

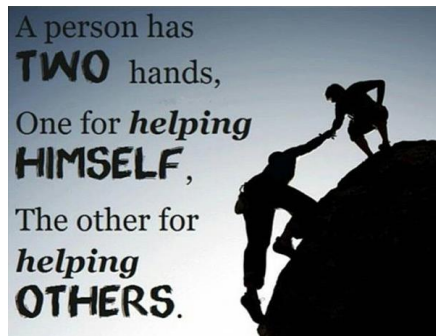


SASS Recognition Week is an opportunity for schools to recognise and acknowledge the important work our School Administrative and Support Staff undertake in schools across NSW.

We have new books and would love to see them being borrowed and enjoyed.

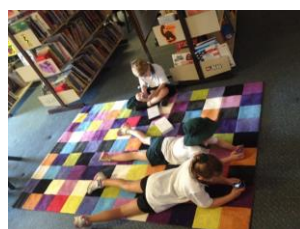

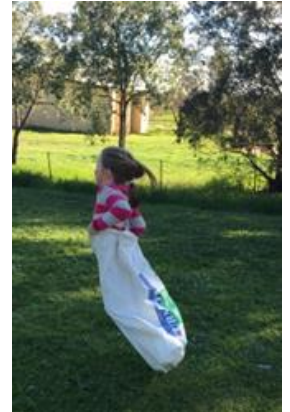

Students enjoyed the Aboriginal dancers who braved the cold to perform.

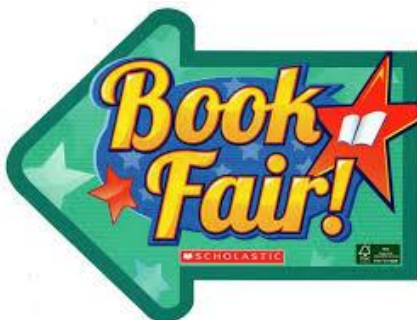

## ACCESS REPORT FOR MATHEMATICS GENERAL 1

In Mathematics General 1 we have almost completed the Higher School Certificate Course. The content of the course is designed to prepare the students for life after school. The last assessment addressed the amount of water and electricity we personally use and the cost of those utilities. We searched the Internet to find the most efficient appliances by looking up the energy rating and the water rating of different brands.

We are working on an assessment which looks at reading and calculating expenses on household bills, such as electricity, gas, water and council rates. Insurance is an important aspect of running a household from a budget point of view whether it is for house and contents, car or life insurance or insurance for loss of pay. We studied probability and using our knowledge calculating the chances of winning lotto and other games of chance.

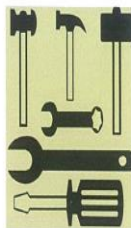

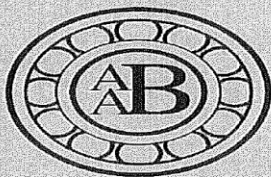
