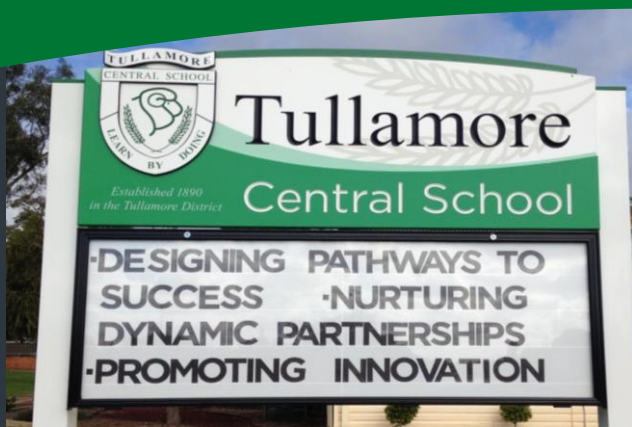

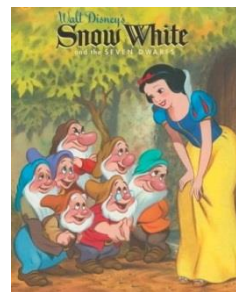

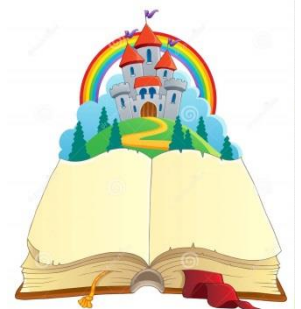
## PRIMARY PIECES

### K/1

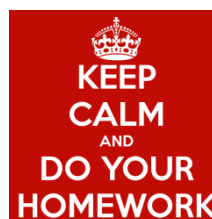

***Fundraising***

Currently we are fundraising for a poly tunnel. This will enable us to grow vegetables that are normally summer crops all year round, such as corn, tomatoes, zucchini, pumpkins etc. So far our vegetable enterprise is supplying our local store with seasonal produce, which is helping us pay for grain feed for our cattle and pay for some expenses, but through expansion we hope to be turning a profit that we can sink in to new and improved enterprises next year such as an aquaculture setup to raise our own barramundi, which will be available for the community to purchase.

## VET Primary Industries – Alice Dorman – Trangie

In Primary Industries students gain vocational skills and knowledge in a range of activities and functions relating to the production and care of livestock and/or plants. Students learn about safety, maintaining and using equipment such as tractors, chemical use, interpreting weather and sustainability. This year the Year 11 and Year 12 course is delivered by Alice Dorman from Trangie. Students cover the theory content of this subject in video conferences and during face to face time with their co teachers they apply the practical skills. Students who are assessed as competent are eligible for a Certificate II in Rural Operations.

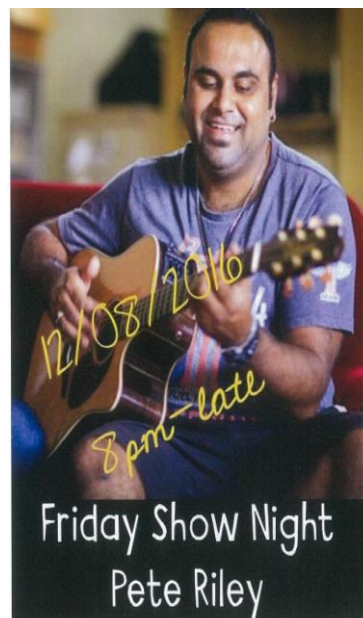
## TULLAMORE SHOW!! 12TH -13TH AUGUST 2016

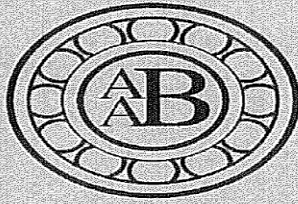
