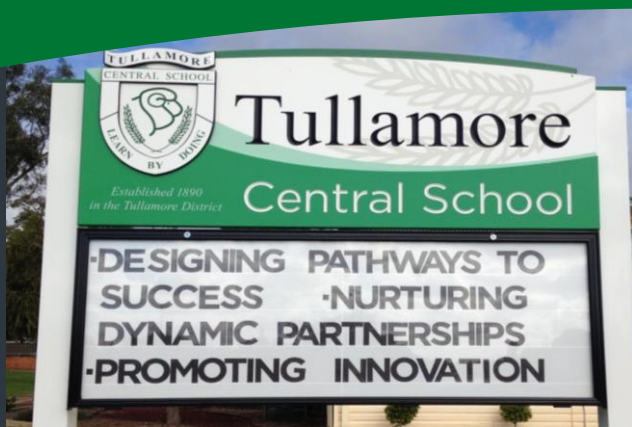

* The Library is a drink and food free zone.

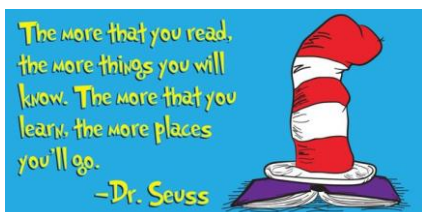
* Library bags are for sale for \$3.00 each.

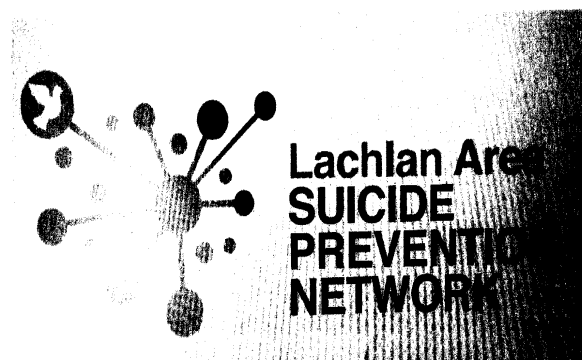
