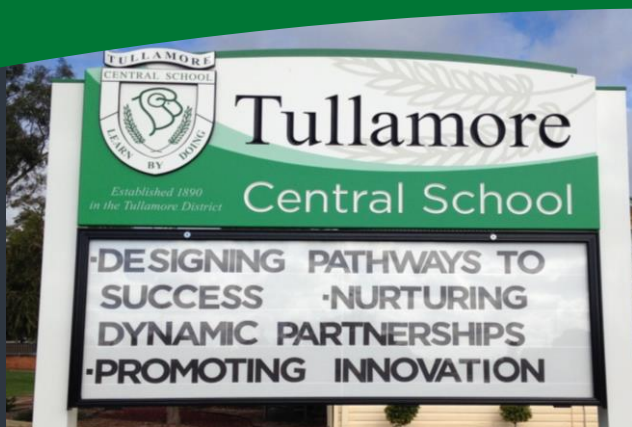

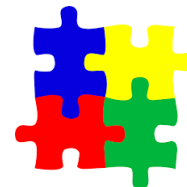

\* Library bags are for sale for \$3.00 each.

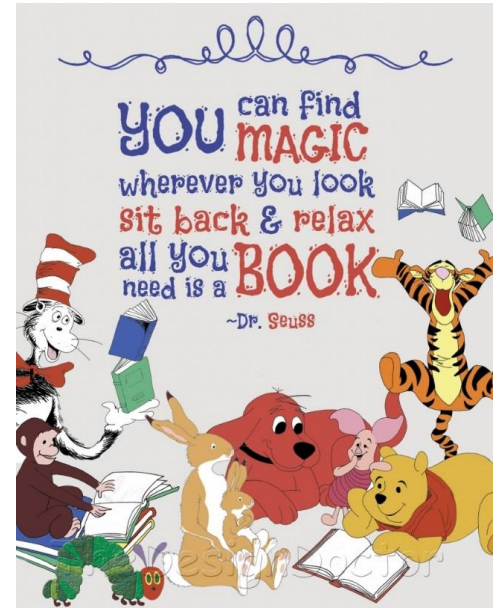
