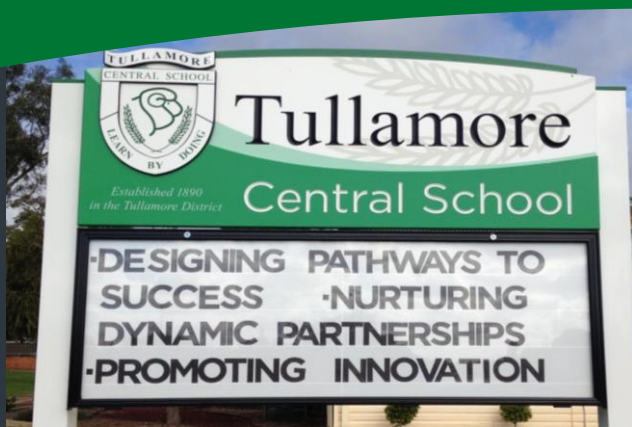

Mother's Day

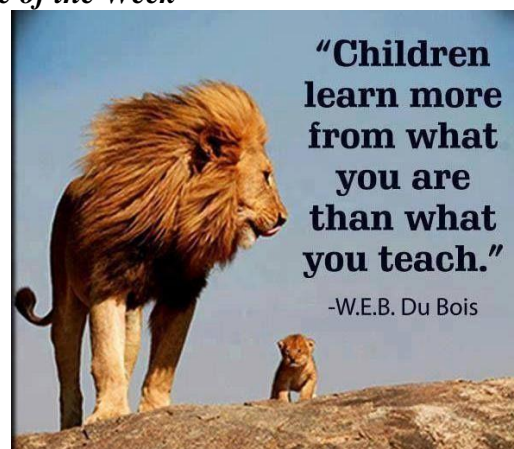

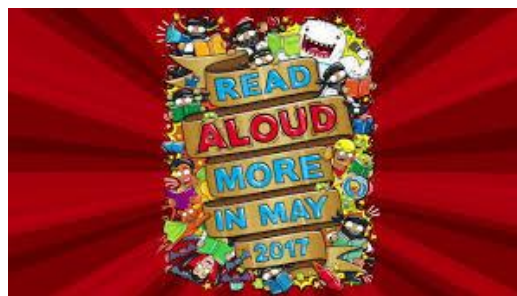

All money raised will go towards the secondary excursion.



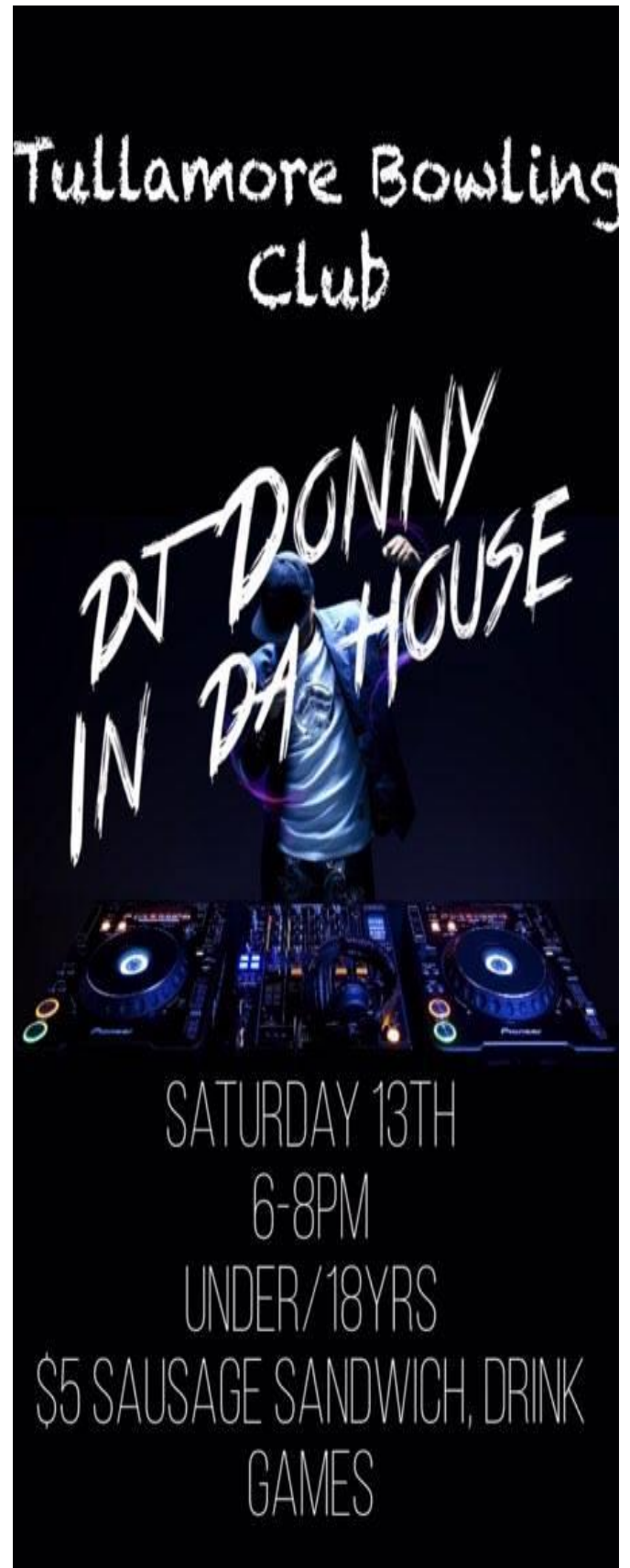
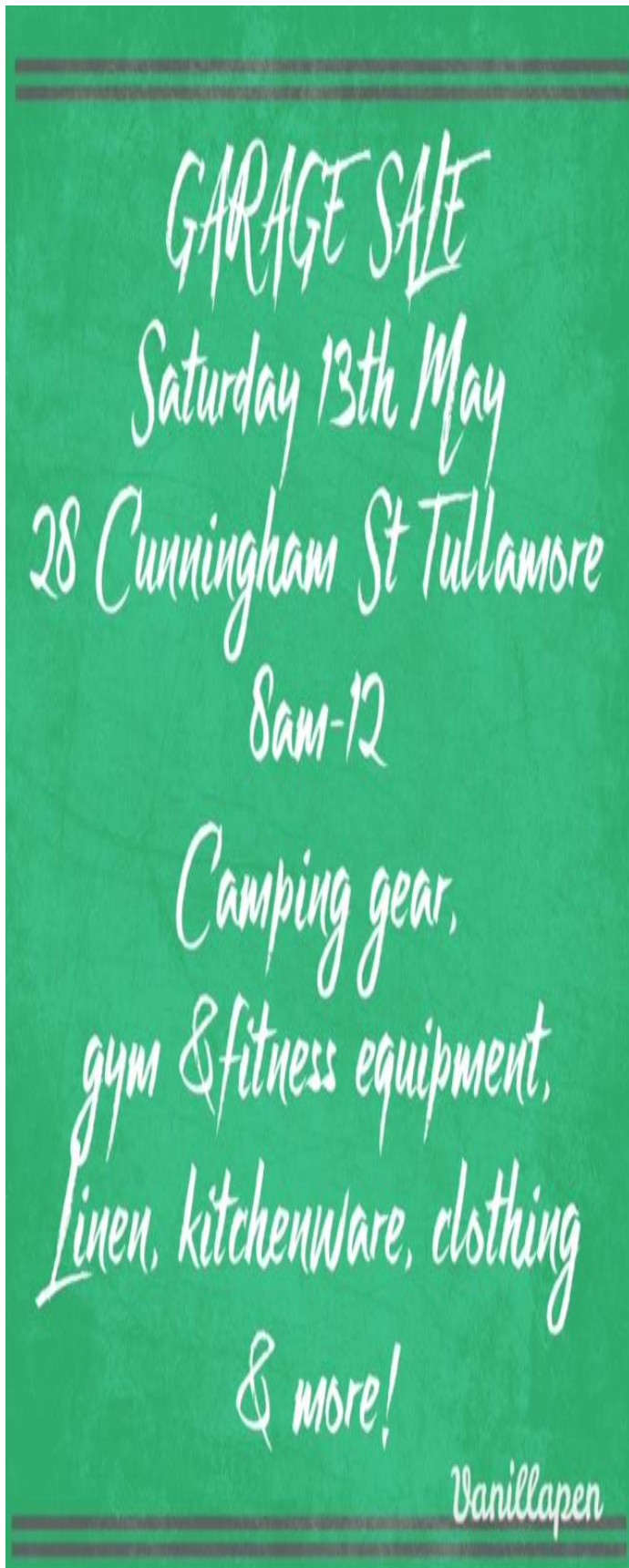
