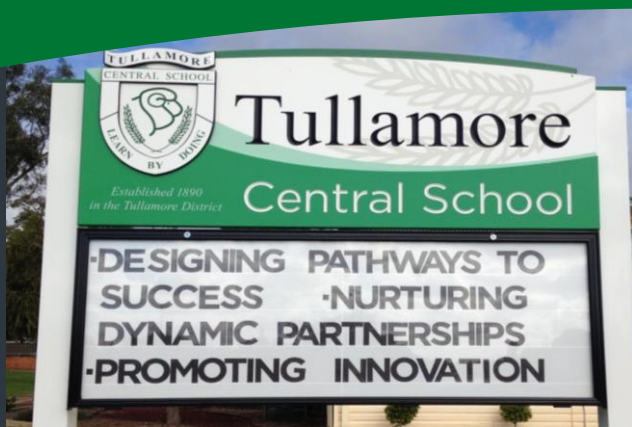

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

NAPLAN

The NAPLAN results analysis package was provided to schools last week. It was exceptionally pleasing to note the significant growth being achieved by our students, overall far in excess of

state average growth rates. An analysis of the growth data of matched students in Years 5,7 and 9 (that is the students who sat NAPLAN at our school 2 years ago and again this year) showed that our student's growth rates are well above state average growth rates in 11 of the 15 possible categories (ie Year 5,7 and 9 Spelling, Reading, Grammar and Punctuation, Writing and Numeracy) In 10 of these categories the growth was between 20-80% higher which is fantastic. We were on par with state average growth in 2 categories and below average growth rates in 2.

I would like to thank our teachers and students for their excellent work in the attainment of these outstanding results and parents for their ongoing support of their children's education.

In coming weeks we will continue to analyse our NAPLAN results to assist us with our 2018 planning process, to support students who are identified as needing more assistance. Individual student results should arrive in schools soon and will then be forwarded to parents.

2018 planning

The speculation around Primary enrolments and class structures is like an unwelcome annual event at Tullamore. We are always very close in terms of maintaining (or losing) a 3rd Primary class. At this stage I would like to confirm that for Term 1, 2018 we will be operating 3 Primary classes. Hopefully we can then maintain that for the entire year but I cannot guarantee that at this point.

In coming weeks we will also be providing information to parents about 7-10 subject selections and curriculum choices for 2018. Year 10 students should by now have been issued with subject selection booklets for Year 11 in 2018. Miss Shankelton is very happy to welcome parents to meetings to discuss choices and options for individual students.

Tell Them From Me Surveys

This year our school is participating in the online "Tell Them From Me" survey process where parents will have the opportunity to provide feedback to our school which will assist us in the 2018-2020 School Planning process. Further information will be provided regarding this very soon and the survey

will be “live” until 13th October to ensure everyone has an opportunity. Watch this space !

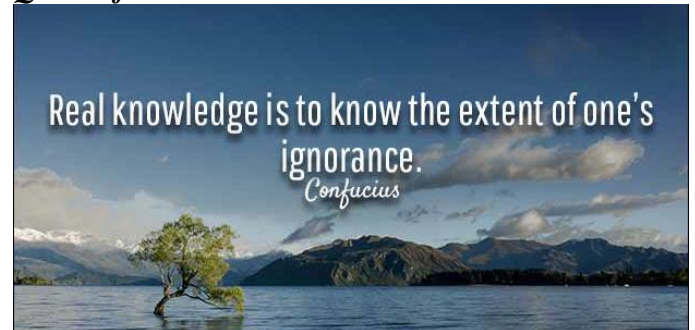

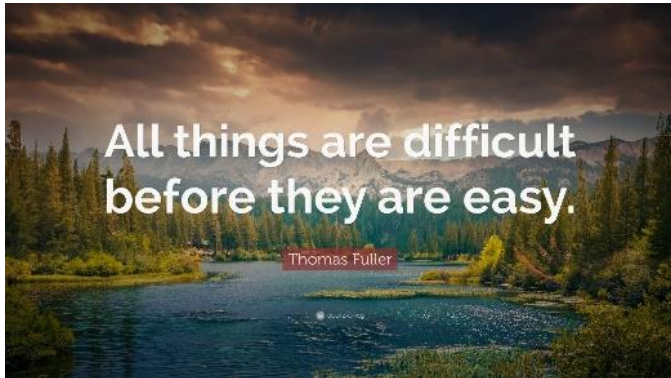

It has been a very hectic few weeks for the Cattle Show Team and the Year 8 Agriculture Class.

Tullamore Show was a great success for our poultry, which won champion and reserve champion Back Yard Fowl. Our cattle team came away with several ribbons, including reserve Champion Junior Heifer.

Our students also competed in the Junior judging of Wool, Sheep and Cattle.

Congratulations to Amie Walker, Jack Darcy, Charlotte Darcy and Anthony Paterson who either placed or were finalists in their respective age groups.

We then competed with the cattle at Trundle Show. Here we won 3 first places and best in breed. Charlotte Darcy and Amie Walker were finalists in the Junior judging.

On Saturday we braved the freezing weather at Bedgerebong Show, taking home a first and second place in the Cow and Heifer classes.

This week our wether challenge team are competing at Dubbo with our Merino Wethers from Egelabra Stud at Warren. At this competition students are judged on their sheep handling, and presentation along with competing in the wool, sheep and carcass judging of our sheep.

On Saturday the cattle show team competes at the last show for us this year which is Condobolin.

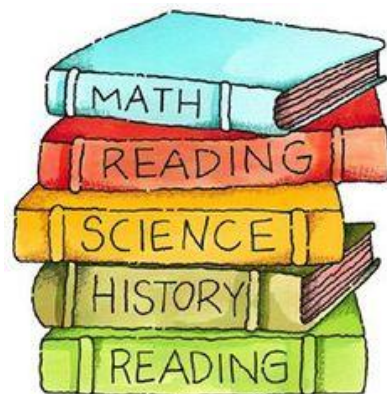

Tullamore Central School will transition to the new NSW Public Schools' finance system and a new bank account on 4th September 2017.

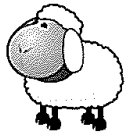
To ensure a smooth transition there will be changes to the way we accept payments from parents and carers.

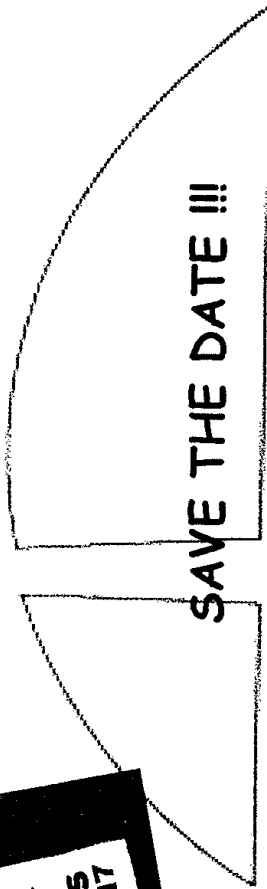

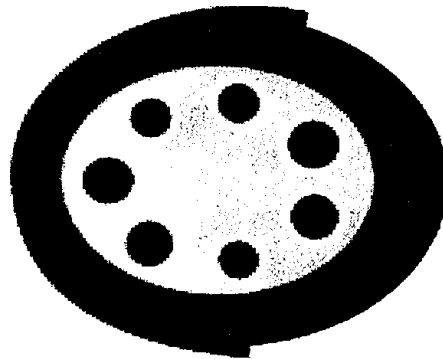
