- staff transport (Tully Bus) students to the pool and watch events. Students will eat lunch at the pool. At the conclusion of the day parents and buses collect students from the pool.

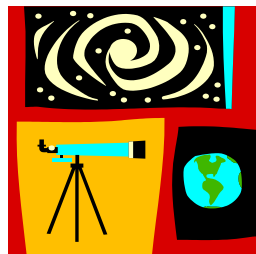

### **Secondary Agriculture and Science**

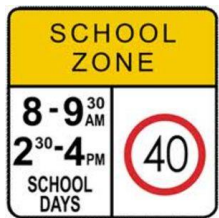

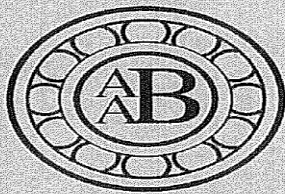
