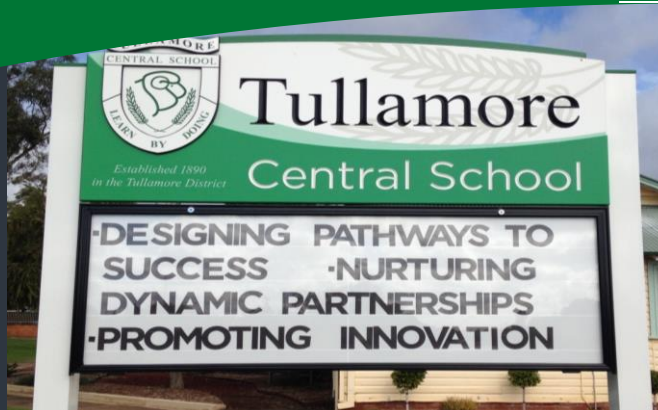

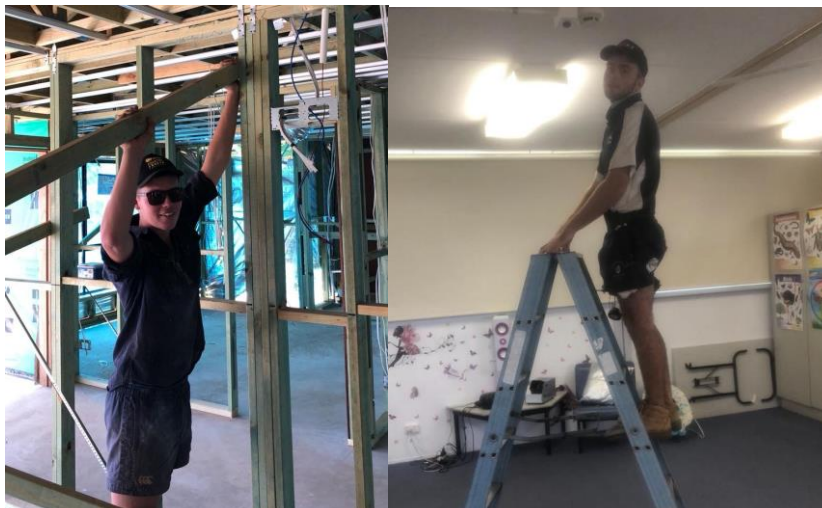

The Irish Festival Street Parade is back!!

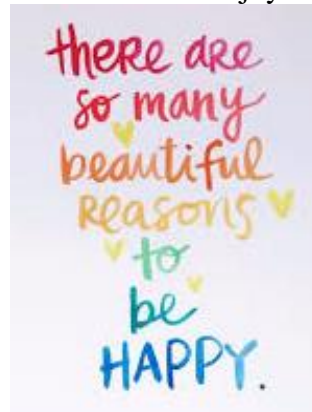

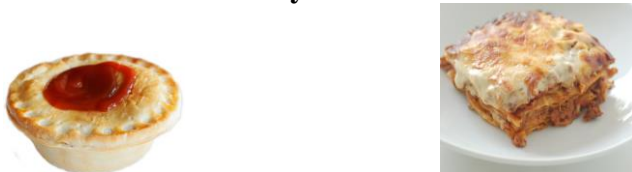

K/1/2 borrow and return books each Monday. Please remember to bring a library bag to school for borrowing.

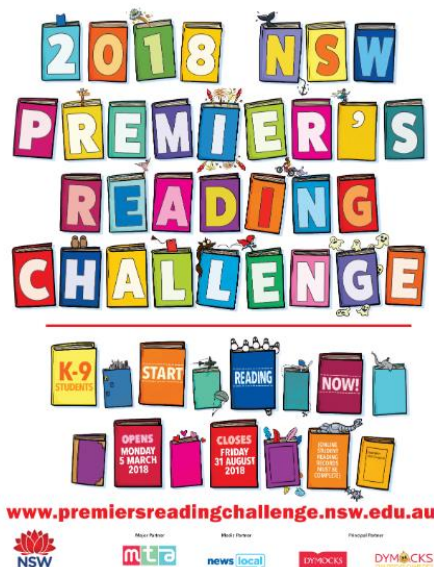
A few reminders

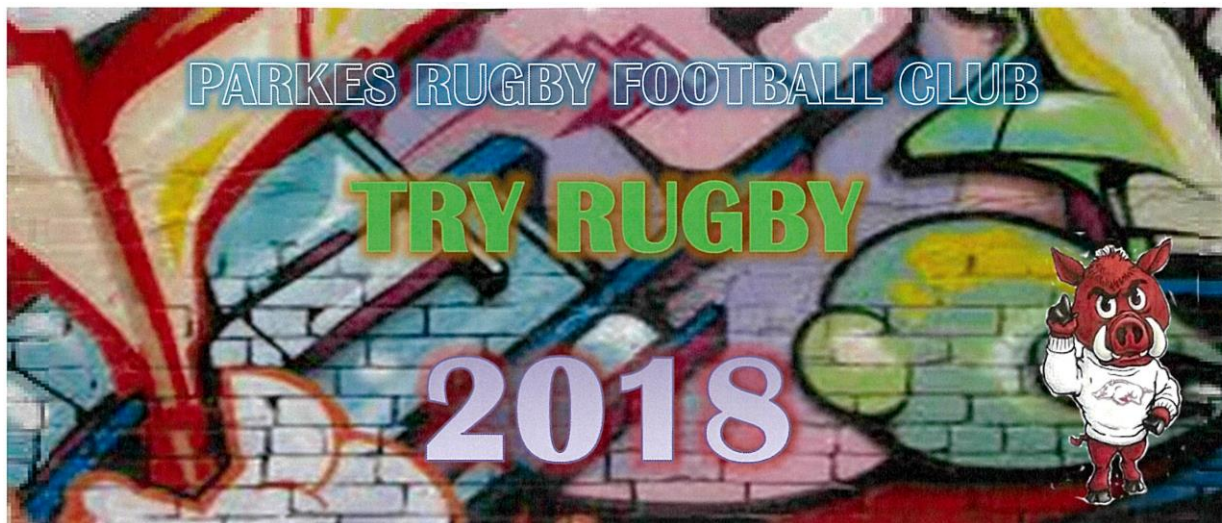
